## Doctoral Training

The University may award a PhD either after the completion of organised doctoral training, or on the basis of individual research undertaken through independent preparation.

During the 36 months of training, 180 credits must be collected.

PhD students studying in the organised doctoral program are either recipients of a Hungarian state scholarship or pay a tuition.

Scholarship holders cannot be employed in a full-time job.

Fields of research for the academic year 2012/2013 are published on the websites of the Doctoral Schools.

Doctoral schools can establish additional requirements, concerning for example level of appropriate qualifications, command of a specific foreign language, professional experience. Further information about the requirements is provided on the websites of the Doctoral Schools.

### Tuition fee

In case of fee-paying students, the exact tuition fees are fixed and published by the Doctoral Schools and can be found on their websites.

### APPLICATION FOR DOCTORAL TRAINING AT THE UP

**Application deadline:** 1 June, 2012

**Probable date of the entrance exam:** second part of June, 2012

#### Application requirements:

- master's or equivalent degree (in the relevant field of study)
- knowledge of at least one foreign language
- experience in basic scientific knowledge and literature of the chosen field of research
- proficiency in the principles, philosophies and methodologies of research.

#### Documents to be submitted for the admission:

- completed application form
- certified true copy of the master's or equivalent degree certificate
- certified true copy of documents demonstrating knowledge of foreign language(s)
- letter of acceptance from the supervisor
- curriculum vitae, documented exposition of scientific and publication activity
- at least one written reference about the professional work and personal attributes of the applicant
- in the case of employed students, a statement from the head of workplace about the assistance offered to the applicant to participate in the training
- opinion of the leader of the receiving research centre about the availability of infrastructure
- statement of the applicant of any prior on-going application or admission to any other doctoral school

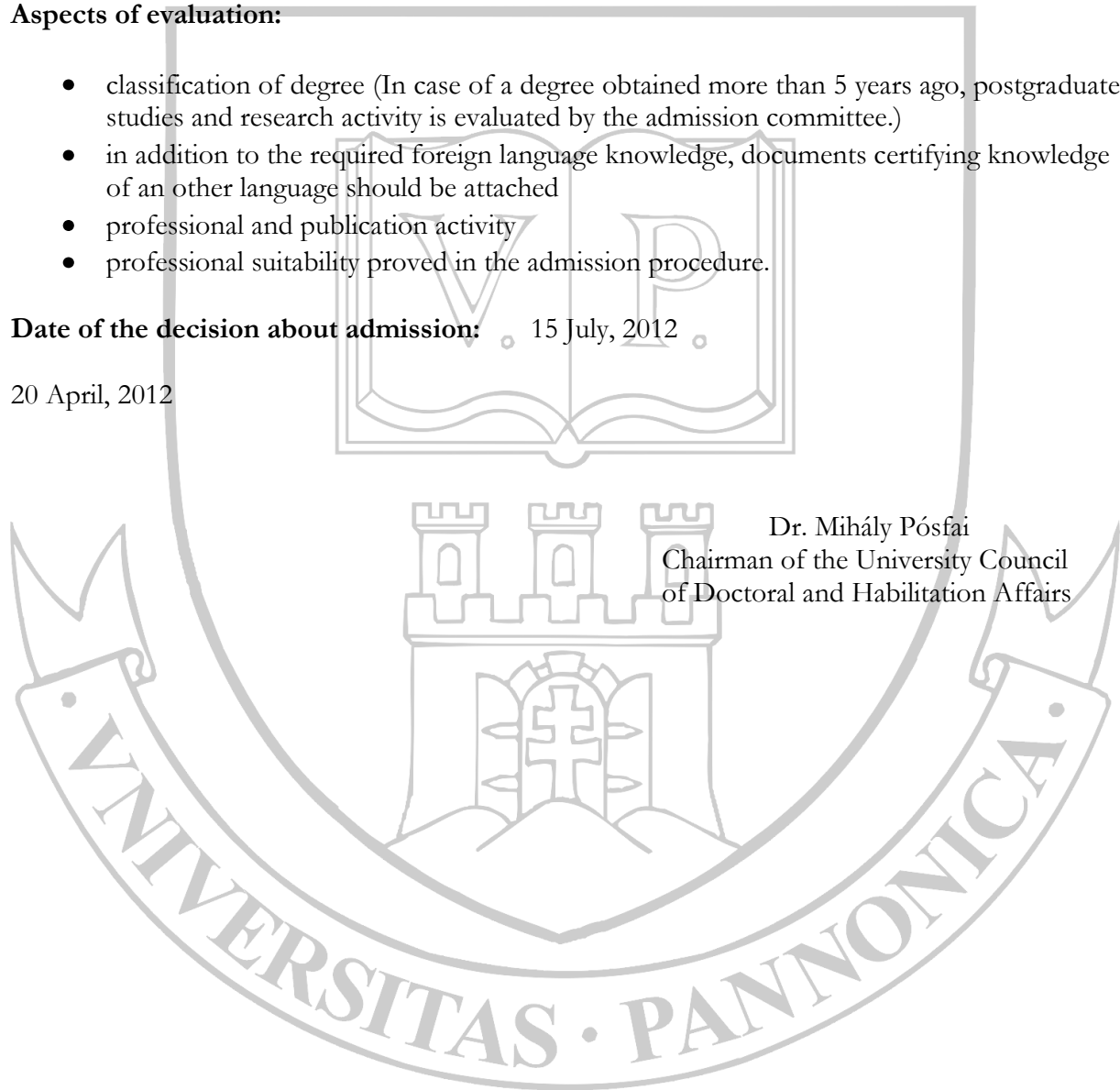
- The applicant should confirm in writing that he/she acknowledges that they are not allowed to be employed in a full-time job.
- verification about the fee paid for the application process (9,000 HUF). The application fee is to be transferred to the bank account of the University of Pannonia. (Name of Bank: Magyar Államkincstár (Hungarian State Treasury); IBAN: HU 55 10048005-01426696-00000000; SWIFT: MANEHUHB; notice: PhD application fee/name/Veszprém or Keszthely )

**Aspects of evaluation:**

- classification of degree (In case of a degree obtained more than 5 years ago, postgraduate studies and research activity is evaluated by the admission committee.)
- in addition to the required foreign language knowledge, documents certifying knowledge of an other language should be attached
- professional and publication activity
- professional suitability proved in the admission procedure.
